Saw Creek Gate Guard Accosted

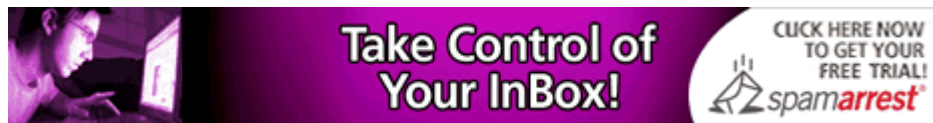
LEHMAN TOWNSHIP, Pa- A woman and her teenage son are in trouble with the law after launching into a tirade at the gate to a Pike County private community.

According to Pennsylvania State Trooper Mike Mulvey, the incident happened around 9:00 P.M. on April 26 when 40-year-old Regina Mason and her son, both Saw Creek residents, drove up to the visitor's gate demanding entry. When asked for identification, Mason allegedly launched into a tirade hurling racial slurs and threats against the gate guard, 27-year-old Alysa Taylor of Allied Security. The teen then threatened to get a gun in order to kill her.

Mason is said to have grabbed the guard by her security necklace nearly pulling the woman out of the guard shack. Mason then went on to allegedly threaten the guard's private property as well as her two children.

Mason was arrested on May 17 and charged with ethnic intimidation, terrorist threats, simple assault, harassment and reckless endangerment. A juvenile petition will be filed against her son charging terrorist threats.
